- 2. Hospitalised with complicated severe acute malnutrition, as per WHO definition
- 3. Started transition from therapeutic milk feeds to RUTF
- 4. Caregiver willing and able to attend the study clinic for all visits
- 5. Caregiver able and willing to give informed consent

#### 7.1 PRINCIPAL EXCLUSION CRITERIA \*

Any acute or chronic condition which mean that receipt of one or more study interventions, or participation in the trial, would not be advisable

#### 7.2 PRIMARY END POINTS \*

The primary endpoints for this trial will be death or first hospitalisation or failed nutritional recovery within 24 weeks post-randomisation.
